ATR VERDICT: GOLDINTHEMOUNTAINS has been lightly raced since winning a bumper at Leopardstown's Christmas meeting in 2023 and comes back from nearly five months off here. When last seen, the Almanzor gelding raced prominently and showed up well for a long way in a hot beginners' chase at Punchestown won by Kitzbuhel. Dropping back in trip should suit and he might take a bit of pegging back. Useful hurdler Royal Hollow is a free-going type and returns from a layoff to make her chasing debut, while Son Of Anarchy has won a point-to-point and probably wants a stiffer test of stamina.
