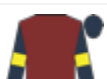
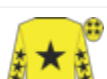
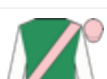
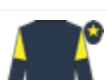
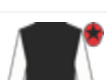
ATR VERDICT: A Listed winner as a juvenile when trained in Britain, BENEVENTO made all the running when successful in a conditions event at Gowran on his second start in Ireland. He has a little bit to find at the weights with a couple of these rivals, but could again be dangerous off the front end. Beaten around seven lengths when an outsider in the Irish 2,000 Guineas, Bamako Beach broke his maiden at Fairyhouse and seems ideally suited by this trip. After an easy maiden win at Limerick, Res Ipsa was turned over at odds-on in a three-runner contest at Killarney, but he remains open to more improvement.

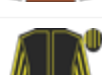
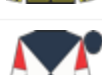
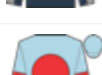

ATR VERDICT: METHGAL was a good second over 7f here on his first run for Dylan Cunha before going one better when dropped to 6f for the first time at Windsor 17 days ago. With Kyle McHugh's 7lb claim more than negating a 4lb rise, another big run looks likely. Von Krolock and My Mate Kev were first and second in a similar event at Lingfield 12 days ago and they can go close if they stage repeats. However, the generally consistent Insuspense could be a bigger danger if matching his peak form starting out for new connections.
